

YOUR NEIGHBOURHOOD POLICING TEAM

You have a dedicated Neighbourhood Policing Team in your area to keep you safe and informed.

They are there to help solve local problems, prevent crime and offer reassurance.

They are a team of Beat Managers (who are Police Constables) and Police Community Support Officers (PCSOs).

Contact your local officer or team and share any concerns you may have about local issues.

If you need to report a crime, call our non-emergency number **101** or report online. In an emergency, always dial **999**.

As well as patrolling your area we will be at:

- **Beat Surgeries and Have Your Say Meetings**

These are held regularly in a variety of public places, such as your local shopping centre, library or community centre.

- **Mobile Police Station**

Look out for our police station on wheels when it comes to your area and pop in to see us.

- **Street Briefings**

These are arranged by the police if there is a specific issue affecting an area so it can be discussed with local residents.

- **Community Events**

We will be at various events in your area, from coffee mornings to festivals.

HELP SET YOUR LOCAL PRIORITIES

Come along and let us know any issues that are concerning you in your area and help to set your local priorities at your **Local Action Group** or **Partners and Communities Together (PACT)** meetings.

Local Action Group and PACT meetings are regular open public meetings, sometimes held as part of other local public meetings, such as Parish/Town Council or Community meetings. They are attended by your Neighbourhood Policing Team and other partner agencies. We will work with you to find the best way to resolve local issues.

You will also receive a local policing update which will include details of what's being done to tackle any issues in your area as well as crime prevention advice.
